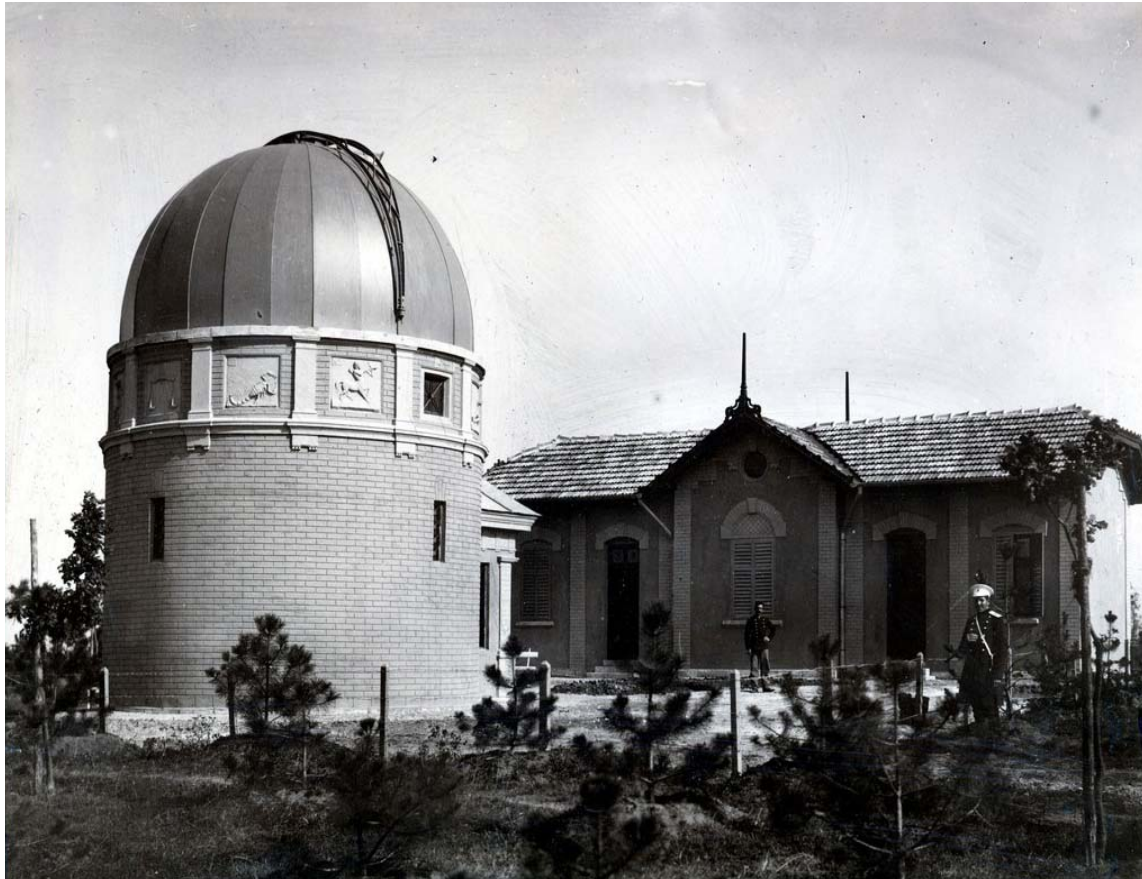

Short historical background



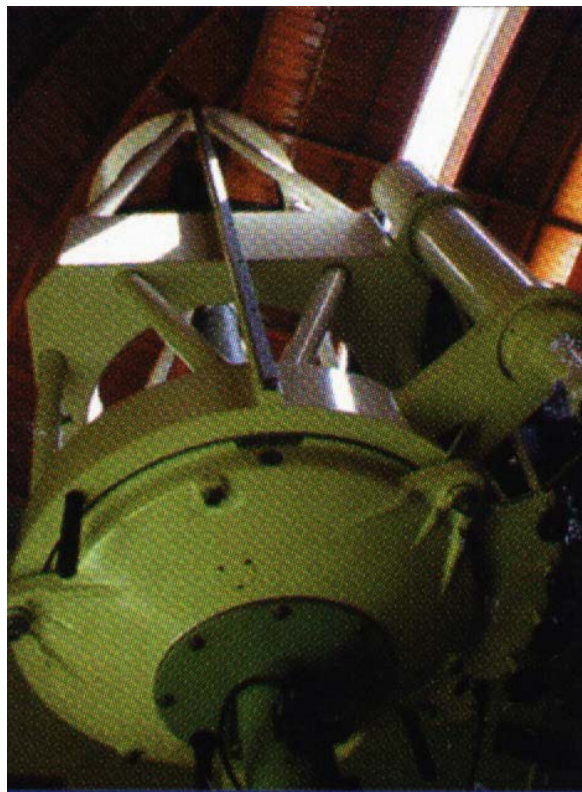
- 1892 - first Bulgarian astronomical observatory
- 1904 - Ciril Popov - first scientific publication in astronomy
- 1952 - Nikola Bonev - first ideas and steps for creating a National Astronomical Observatory

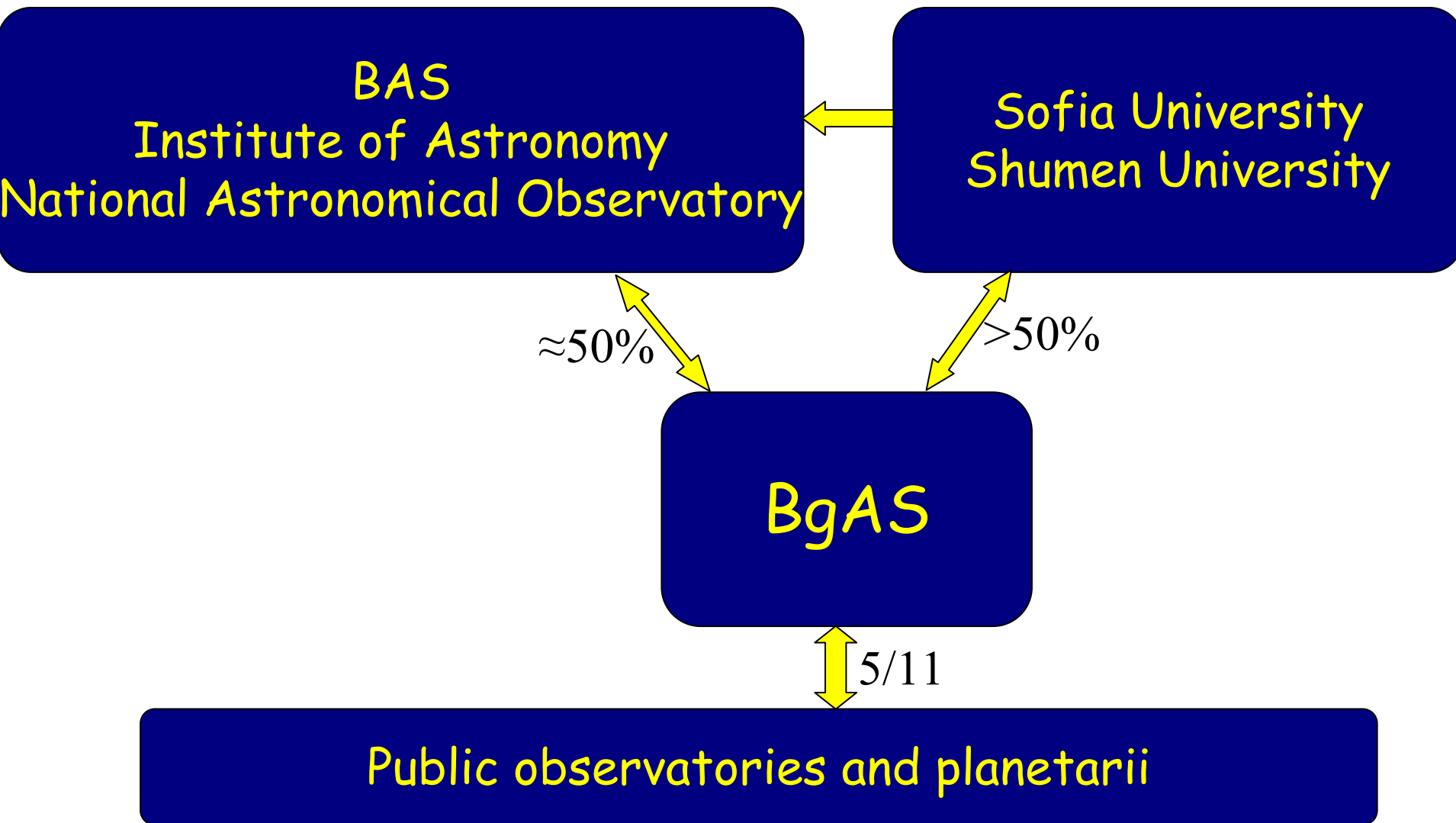
Public observatories

2000 - establishment of the Bulgarian Astronomical Society (BgAS)



Extracted from the constitution

- BgAS is a voluntary non-governmental organization.
- It unites professional and nonprofessional astronomers.
- It is opened for all friends of astronomy.

Main objectives of BgAS

- To promote the progress of astronomy.
- To enhance the social prestige of astronomy .
- To create links between professional and amateur astronomers.

How to achieve these objectives?

- ❑ By supporting the research and educational work of its members.
- ❑ By popularizing the attainments of astronomy.
- ❑ By participating the formation of national politics and strategy concerning astronomy.
- ❑ By maintaining close relations with international astronomical organizations.
